THIS CLEANUP IS NOT FOR—

- Curbside appliance
- Electronic recycling
- Items that fit in your weekly trash pickup container

Recycle appliance/electronic items during Cottonwood County's recycling events.

— CURB —

Each household is allowed curbside pickup of—

■ 10 LARGE HOUSEHOLD GOODS OR FURNITURE

Place items at the curb by 6:00 a.m., Saturday, May 18th. **DO NOT** place items in alley!

Only 10 items will be picked up. If more than 10 items are placed on the curb the property owner will be responsible for proper disposal of the remaining items.

Items with glass/mirror ARE NOT ALLOWED. All glass/mirror items can be taken to the drop off site.

DO NOT PLACE appliances or electronics on the curb. Recycle these items during Cottonwood County's recycling events.

No items in garbage bags!

— DROP OFF —

■ ADDITIONAL SMALL ACCEPTABLE ITEMS—

Can be dropped off at Cottonwood Lake (Tegels Park) dumpster location
7:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

All items brought to the site must be in an open box and visible for inspection no bags will be allowed. Proof of City of Windom residency (drivers license or utility bill) will be required to drop off items.

UNACCEPTABLE materials for pickup or drop off include —

- Appliances
- Building materials
- Fluorescent tubes
- Electronics
- Lead acid batteries
- Used oil
- Household garbage
- Liquid waste
- Auto bodies
- Hazardous waste
- Paints
- Tires
- Concrete

■ MATTRESS RECYCLING—

Thursday & Friday,
May 16th & 17th
for mattress or box spring

If you have either of these for pickup during the cleanup event, you must purchase a tag from City Hall by Tuesday, May 14th. Tags are \$9.00 each limit 2. Additional tags are \$17.00.

Please keep items dry, stand mattresses on edge and place on the curb before 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 16th, for pickup. **Mattresses and box springs without tags WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.** Car seats are free.

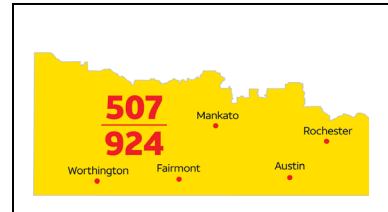

Area Code Overlay Approved for the Minnesota 507 Area Code

To make sure new telephone numbers are available, the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission approved the addition of the new 924 area code to the geographic region of the 507 area code. This process is known as an area code overlay.

What is an area code overlay?

An overlay is the addition of another area code (924) to the same geographic region as an existing area code (507). An overlay does not require customers to change their existing area code but does require using a new dialing procedure to complete calls.



Who will be affected?

The 507 area code covers southern Minnesota and cities including, but not limited to Albert Lea, Austin, Fairmont, Mankato, Northfield, Rochester, Winona, Worthington, and other smaller communities. Anyone with a 507 area code will need to use a new dialing procedure, but will not have to change their telephone number. New telephone numbers may be assigned in the new 924 area code.

What will be the new dialing procedure?

All calls in the 507 area code geographic area that are currently dialed with seven digits will need to be dialed using area code + telephone number. The same dialing procedure will apply to both 507 telephone numbers and telephone numbers that are assigned in the new 924 area code.

When will the change begin?

Effective **January 30, 2024**, dial the area code + telephone number whenever you place a call. If you forget and dial just seven digits, your call will still be completed.

Beginning **July 30, 2024**, you must dial the area code + telephone number on all calls, including calls within your same area code. If you do not dial the area code + telephone number, your call will not be completed, and a recording will instruct you to hang up and dial again, including the area code.

Beginning **August 30, 2024**, new telephone lines or services may be assigned numbers with the new 924 area code.

What will change?

- Dial the area code + telephone number for local calls.
- All services, automatic dialing equipment, or other types of equipment that are programmed to dial a 7-digit number will need to be reprogrammed to include the area code. Some examples are: life safety systems and medical monitoring devices, fire or burglar alarm and security systems or gates, fax machines, Internet dial-up numbers, speed dialers, call forwarding settings, voicemail services and similar functions, etc.
- Update your websites, personal and business stationery and checks, advertising materials, personal and pet ID tags and other such items to ensure the area code is included.

What will remain the same?

- Your telephone number, including current area code.
- The price of a call, coverage area, or other rates and services will not change due to the overlay.
- What is a local call now will remain a local call regardless of the number of digits dialed.
- You can still dial just three digits to reach 911 and 988, as well as 211, 311, 411, 511, 611, 711 or 811 if available in your area.
