

Scheduled Local Generation – Possible OUTAGE
Saturday August 25th 2018

On Saturday August 25th the Windom Electric Department is planning on generating the City's entire electrical load so that the new substation can be brought on-line. The generation is planned for a weekend when the City's electrical demand is lower. During this conversion we are asking the public to CONSERVE as much electricity as possible.

At approximately 6:30 am August 25th we will be disconnected from the incoming ITC transmission line. When switching to and from ITC's transmission to the City's generation we do not expect any fluctuation in the delivery of electricity. During this disconnection our plan is to completely power the town through our own generation. To complete the construction work we plan to generate until approximately 3:00 pm.

While on generation, we urge the public to try do their best to conserve electricity. Keeping lights off and turning air conditioners to higher temps, or even off, if the weather allows. We are hoping for cooler weather and an earlier construction completion time to help keep the load on the generators down.

In the event the City's electric demand becomes too much for our generators to supply we will be forced to turn off some circuits which will cause an outage in parts of town. Should it be necessary to turn off these circuits they will need to remain off until regular ITC power transmission is restored.
